The American Joint Replacement Registry (AJRR), in collaboration with the American Orthopaedic Association's (AOA) Own the Bone program, and the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons (AAHKS) presents the AJRR Orthopaedic Quality Resource Center, approved by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) as a Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR). Started in 2014, the QCDR method provides a new standard to complete Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) requirements based on satisfactory participation. A QCDR is a CMS-approved entity that collects medical and/or clinical data for the purpose of patient and disease tracking to foster improvement in the quality of care furnished to patients.

This registry is approved by CMS as a Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR) for Eligible Professionals and GPRO Practices.

MEASURES THAT MATTER

This registry includes 38 approved PQRS and custom measures.



Up to 9% of your 2018 medicare payments are at risk for non-participation in the Meaningful Use, PQRS, & VBM programs.

M IMPROVEMENT INTERVENTIONS TO CLOSE GAPS IN PATIENT CARE


The registry identifies possible interventions for improvement based on clinical quality gaps found through calculating your selected quality measures.
